It was just a matter of days after Hurricane Katrina hit when we conceived the "New Orleans: Proud to Swim Home" bumper sticker, which can now be seen on the back of tens of thousands of cars of returning residents and simultaneously raised money for Habitat for Humanity and the Humane Society.

In this spirit, we are also calling the compilation "Proud to Swim Home" as a tribute to everyone who committed to return to their City to rebuild and to those who have personally volunteered and given to help New Orleans' rebuild in spite of the continued massive failure of the American system to save it.
